As a result of participating in the project what do you think has been the most significant change for you personally?

Well, it was nice to see them and get to know them you know? And now I know about the art group so if I go to the class, somebody is there that I know.

What caused this change?

I done pottery and I haven't done that since school so that was different. Having people in the house was all good.

If you were to tell other people about People Speak Up, what would you say?

It's a good group to join you know? Even if it is for a short while and it all helps when they come to your home especially for those that don't go out and see people, it's benefitted me.
